Attractions

- **Atlanta Botanical Garden** – *Alice's Wonderland* through Sept. 14, and *Enchanted Trees* by *Poetic Kinetics* – Hours: 9am–9pm, closed Mon.; \$29.
- **Georgia Aquarium** – Hours: 9am–9pm; \$68.
- **High Museum of Art** – Great folk art section and contemporary art; current exhibition *Faith Ringgold: Seeing Children* – Hours: 10am–5pm, closed Mon.; \$23.50.
- **Martin Luther King Jr. National Historical Park and King Center** – Hours: 9am–5pm (historical park) and 10am–5pm (center); free.
- **Fernbank Science Museum** – Hours: 10am– 5pm; \$28. Sept. 12: *Fernbank After Dark: Sense and Sense-ability*, 7–11 pm; \$24.
- **Sencer CDC Museum** – Hours: 9am–5pm weekdays (til 7pm Thurs.), closed Sat. and Sun.; free.
- **Atlanta History Center and Cyclorama** – Hours: 9 am – 4 pm, closed Mon.; \$27.
- **National Center for Civil and Human Rights** – Hours: Mon.–Sat. 10am–5pm, Sun. 12pm–5pm; \$20.
- **World of Coca Cola** – Hours: 10am–7pm Mon.–Thurs., 10am–9pm Fri. and Sat.; \$25.

Parks, Trails, and Food Halls

- **Piedmont Park** – Atlanta's largest park. Great place to walk, skate, run or bike. Next door to Botanical Gardens; free.
- **Westside Reservoir Park** – New large park, formerly a quarry, near the Foundry; free.
- **Ponce City Market** – Large food hall on Eastside Beltline trail.
- **Chattahoochee Food Works** – Food hall near the Foundry and site of our Sat. social.
- **Beltline** – Biking/walking trail on former freight train track.
- **Chattahoochee Nature Ctr. and Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area**; \$5–10.
